This year's event will take place at the beautiful University of Pennsylvania Museum of Archaeology and Anthropology in Philadelphia.

Dedicated to the study and understanding of human history and diversity, the UPM was founded in 1887 and has since sent more than 400 archaeological and anthropological expeditions to all inhabited continents in the world. Approximately one million artifacts are housed at the Museum, including one of the largest sphinxes outside of Egypt, the Sphinx of Ramesses II, a red granite sculpture weighing 12 tons and a collection of monumental Chinese and Buddhist sculptures regarded as among the finest in the United States.
